#### **Class cost**

New members have the option of a two week trial for £15, Half an hour: £4.30, Three-quarters of an hour: £6.50, One hour class: £8.30, 1hr dance cirque class £10. Classes are paid for via direct debit, We will calculate the total cost of the classes your child takes for the year and spread it across 12 monthly payments. This means you will pay a consistent monthly fee, making it easier to budget and track payments. We will obviously deduct the days that there are no classes on.

There are no refunds if a class is missed, if the school cancel a class you will be credited for your classes. If you do need to change a class, drop a class or leave the dance school a 4 week notice period is required, otherwise you will be invoiced for the next half term. The dance schools payment policy can be found on the school website.

**Senior & Advanced** 

Senior and Advanced dancers have a wide range of classes including Pointe Work, alongside being able to take part in school trips (example: London), performing at dance conventions alongside exams

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### Exams & Shows

We have achievement awards with the i-PATH examination body. These are taken in all styles and the required preparation and information will be given to each student. These are not compulsory.

Throughout the year the school hold recitals for parents & guardians to showcase what we have been working on in class. This is also a great opportunity for students to gain confidence for shows.

We have previously held summer and winter shows at some incredible venues to showcase our school and its talents. We will continue to work on putting on fantastic shows for students to participate in, this years show information can be found in our structure and focus page.

Alongside awards and shows, we also provide opportunities for students to perform at venues such a Blackpool tower and take trips to London to participate in workshops and see west end shows.

Students will also have the opportunity to receive in class 'dancer of the week' & WOW cards to highlight achievements. Report cards are also given out to highlight progress during the academic year.

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# **Payment Policy**



We are so excited to announce we will be moving our class bookings onto a new system from September! This will make payments easier for you. We will calculate the total cost of the classes your child takes for the year and spread it across 12 monthly payments. This means you will pay a consistent monthly fee, making it easier to budget and track payments. We will obviously deduct the days that there are no classes on. This will be so much more convenient for you and our school, as we collect fees automatically via subscription.

Payments will be automatically taken online from your bank account on the 1st of each month through GoCardless. You will receive details on how to sign up for a GoCardless account at the beginning of August and will have one month to complete your registration. Please ensure funds are available on the 1st of each month to cover the cost of your child's classes.

If you need to cancel your child's classes, a one-month notice period is required. For example, to cancel classes starting in December, you must inform us by November 1st. If a payment fails on the 1st of the month, a second attempt will be made a few days later. After a third failed attempt, a £5 admin fee will be added to your monthly bill. If the payment still fails, unfortunately, your child will not be able to participate in classes until the payment is resolved.

Remember we will take payment every month even in August when there are no classes, as the class payment is split across 12 months.



# FAQs

### Ages for classes

Classes are broken down in the different age groups, information of the timetable for the different ages can be found on the school website.

•	Parent & Toddler
•	Diddy Dance for Reception, YR1 & YR2
•	Juniors for YR3, YR4 & YR5
•	Seniors for YR6, YR7, YR8 & YR9 (Depending on dance background)
•	Advanced YR9 onwards
•	Adult 18+

#### **Class cost**

New members have the option of a two week trial for £15, you can take as many classes as you like during this trial. After this classes are £4.30 per half, £6.50 45mins and hour and £8.30 per hour. There are no refunds if a class is missed, if the school cancel a class you will be credited for your classes.

If you do need to change a class, drop a class or leave the dance school a 4 week notice period is required, otherwise you will be invoiced for the next half term. The dance schools payment policy can be found on the school website.

### Parking

St Annes have a car park to use free of charge

Hopwood village hall, this car park is not in use of a Saturday due to the volume of traffic we have coming to the dance school, however the Westmead hotel which is a 1 minute walk away from the village hall has a large park for us to use

Parking can be limited outside Alvechurch village hall, but the village car park is a 1 minute walk away from the village hall and is located on Tanyard lane
